

HOME FOR CHRISTMAS

What you make:

A tiny Christmas house decoration approximately 2 1/2 inches by 4 1/2 inches

What you need:

Four scraps of fabric approx 3 inches by 5 inches
Scrap of wadding 3 1/2 inches by 5 inches
Fusible webbing
3 inch length of ric-rac

What you do:

Trace house, roof, door and window shapes onto the paper side of fusible webbing.

Roughly cut around shapes, then iron them onto the reverse of selected fabrics.

Cut out along drawn lines.

Cut a 3 1/2 inch by 5 inch rectangle of fusible webbing and iron it onto the reverse of selected fabric for the back of the house decoration. Trim backing fabric to the size of the rectangle of fusible webbing.

Remove paper backing from 3 1/2 inch by 5 inch rectangle of backing fabric. Iron this rectangle onto the back of the scrap of wadding.

Remove paper backing from house shapes. Arrange these onto the front of a scrap of wadding. Slightly overlap the house over the roof shape.

Use free motion stitching to stitch around all shapes in a matching thread.

Trim away excess wadding and backing fabric to the edge of the house.

Form a loop with the ric-rac. Use free motion stitching to attach it to the top of the decoration.

Hang it on your tree!
